CALL TO ORDER: by Shelby Schoenfelder at 6:32pm

- **Maintenance and Bylaws** - Tylynn proposed to move the last bullet point about bylaws, Fire suppression system and tractor clutch was repaired, high voltage project exceeds the \$50,000 Amazon fund limit. \$80,000 study will be needed in order to use the funds for the flood mitigation. Will vote on new bylaws to be submitted to the BOC. Bylaws were voted on and approved
- **Weigh-in** - Will ask the sheriff's office for help with traffic on Tuesday and Wednesday. Tuesday (8am-9am goat weigh-in) (5-7pm for sheep), Wednesday (6-8am swine) (8-10am beef)
- **Wranglers** - Need a formal, long-term agreement for fee situation and arena usage, will involve multiple other departments
- **Drawing Contest** - Selected the design that features the Flag, a jet, and the 4-H flag. A coloring book will be made of all the designs.
- **Catering** - Sharon Helms for buyers' lunch, will need more for Wednesday's dinner
- **Fair Week Planning** - kickoff dinner on Wednesday the 19th (200-250 people) sponsored by Three-Mile. Alvin will only bring his truck Saturday night. Tylynn needs help finding local entertainment groups throughout the week, possibly a talent show, ag Olympics, something for teens. Needs volunteers for setup/cleaning, maybe groups wanting community service hours. In need of a horticulture and creative kids superintendents. The art center is bringing an art trailer to the fair. Will work with Ken Grieb on the premium book dedication.
- **Veterans Recognition Event** - Could have the event on Thursday from 5:30-6:30pm with a presentation similar to the HHS one, Tylynn will reach out to Jeannie Collins for ideas.
- **Premium Payout Collection** - Have an agreement about collecting cash by a certain time or donate it to the fair. Fair Board voted to include this this year.
- **Entertainment** - Problems with budget. Need to secure entertainment sponsors. Some schedule changes will be needed for John King. Could change from John King, his contract is not finalized, to someone more local and cheaper.
- **Premium Book** - Will be digital in upcoming years with the exception of some printed copies for elders, will be able to distribute with QR codes and brochures.
- **Ribbon Order** - total: \$314.60 for stickers, \$7,101.60 for ribbons, increase from last year to avoid shortage.
